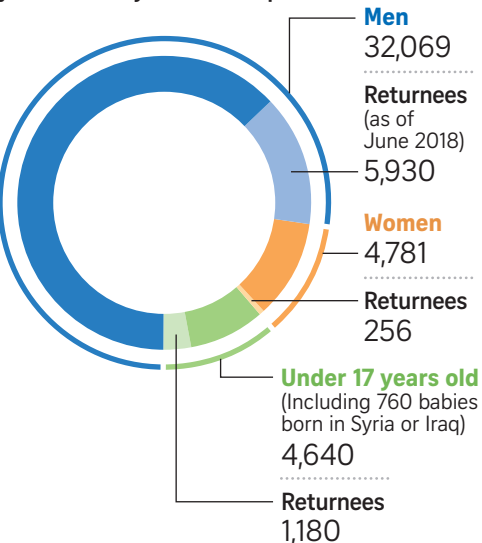


ISIS foreign fighters, supporters and their children

According to a study published by the International Centre for the Study of Radicalisation last year, some 41,490 citizens from 80 countries travelled to Syria and Iraq to join ISIS and fight, to accompany and support fighters, or were taken there as children.

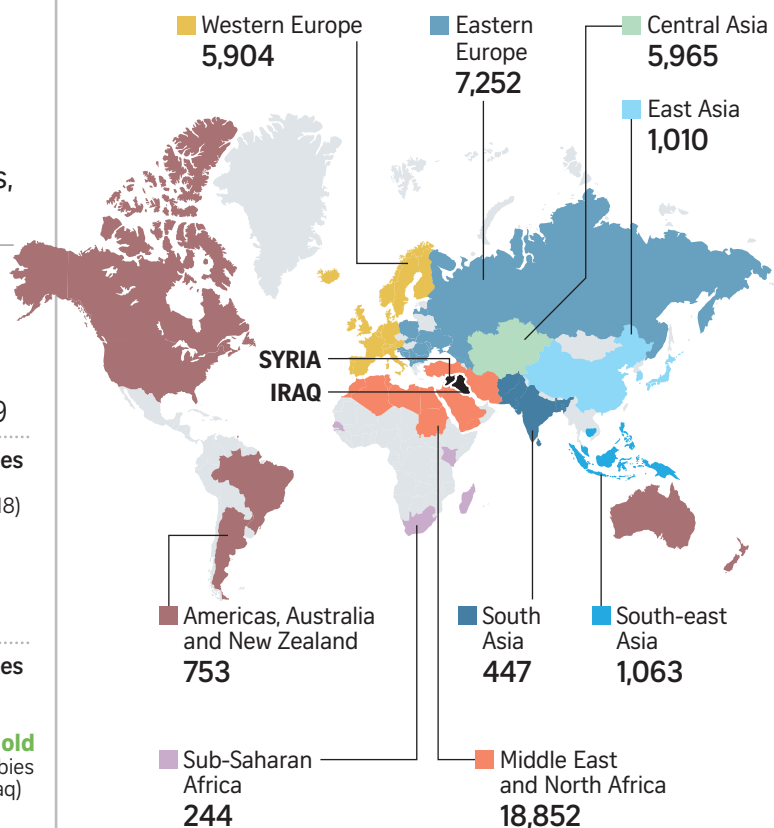
TOTAL FOR 2013-2018

WHERE THEY CAME FROM



At its peak in late 2014 it was believed ISIS controlled **over 100,000 sq km of land with 11 million residents**

ISIS and those inspired by the group had as of June 2018 carried out **over 4,300 attacks across at least 29 countries**
