

A connected Rail Corridor by 2021

The 24km stretch will run from the Woodlands Regional Centre, which will house an agri-food innovation park, all the way down to the Greater Southern Waterfront.



Stagmont Ring Community Node

One of eight "activity nodes" along the Rail Corridor, it is proposed as a community hub with programmes and facilities such as community farms, playgrounds and fishing ponds for families.



Choa Chu Kang – future housing

The Rail Corridor will be integrated with future housing in the area as well as Pang Sua Canal. One of the housing concepts includes a "linear forest" of high-rise blocks in harmony with greenery.



Rifle Range Nature Park

Highlights include a former quarry restored as a freshwater habitat, improved hiking trails and habitat for wildlife.



Silat

The upcoming residential development will have an access park leading to the Rail Corridor when completed by 2023.

Kranji

Located across Kranji MRT station, the node can be the start of the Rail Corridor journey for both residents and workers in the north.



Bukit Timah Fire Station

This node will feature a forest walk and observation tower for panoramic views of Bukit Timah Nature Reserve.



Bukit Timah Railway Station / Station Master's Quarters

The station will be revitalised into a distinctive community node that highlights its heritage and will include various spaces for the community to enjoy.



one-north Business Park

At Buona Vista, near one-north, the Rail Corridor will become a vibrant activity space where workers and residents enjoy activities such as outdoor film screenings.
