 **Take leave on this day**

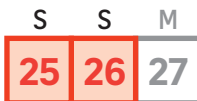

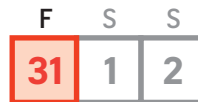

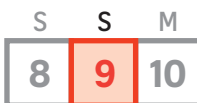
