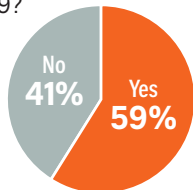


Money matters

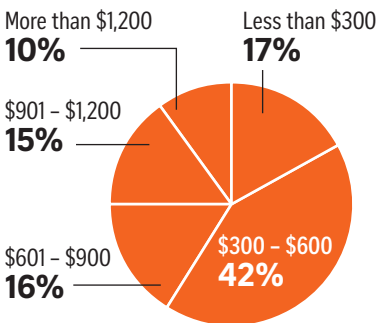
Question for participants in the poll who are retirees:
