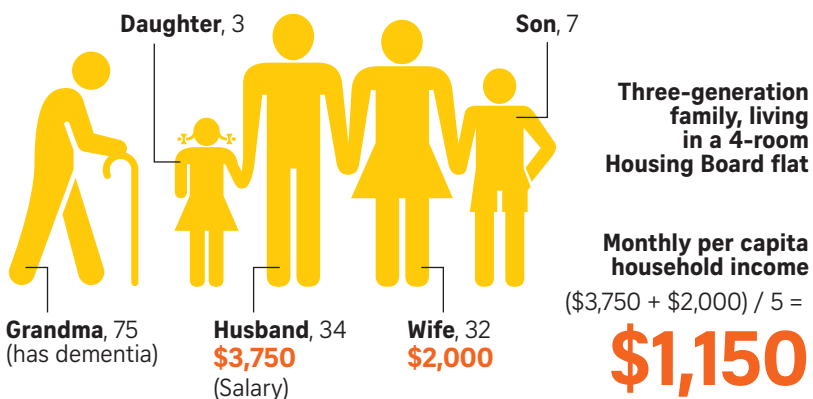

Some of the schemes also have other criteria, such as annual value of the property of residence, age and disability assessment, which will affect the household's subsidy eligibility for these schemes. Such non-per capita household income eligibility criteria remain unchanged.
