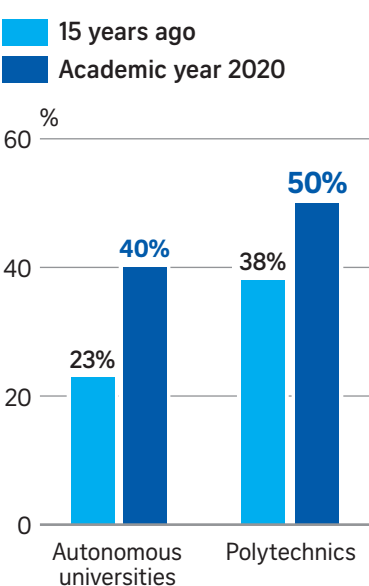


# Making fees affordable for all

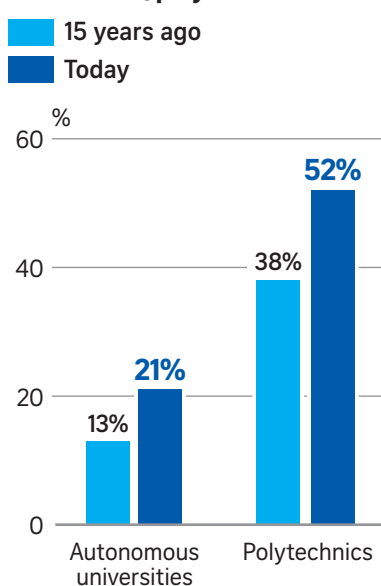
As more Singaporeans make it to universities and polytechnics, the Government will increase bursaries from next year to ensure tuition fees remain affordable.
