TWO ISLANDS TO BE SPLIT INTO FIVE ZONES

Vibrant Cluster
It spans the two islands, will have large-scale attractions.
- 2

Island Heart
It will feature hotels, conference spaces, dining and retail shops.
- 3

Waterfront
On Pulau Brani, it will house a "futuristic" Discovery Park.
- 4

Ridgeline
It will connect green spaces from Mount Faber to Mount Imbiah and feature nature and heritage attractions.

Beachfront
It will be rejuvenated with a water show, fairgrounds and other attractions.
