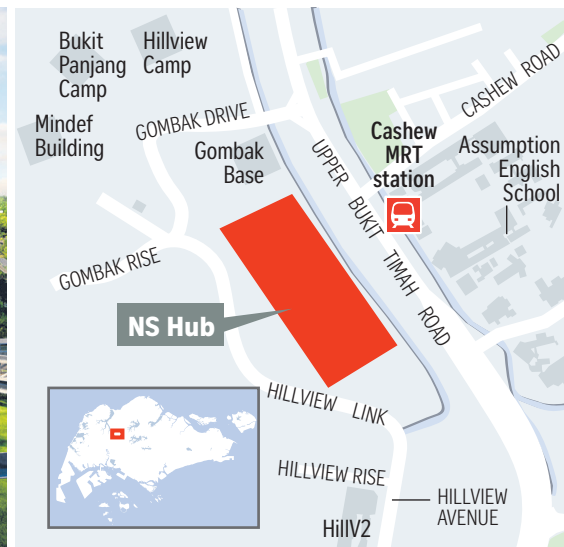


Eco-friendly features and smart tech

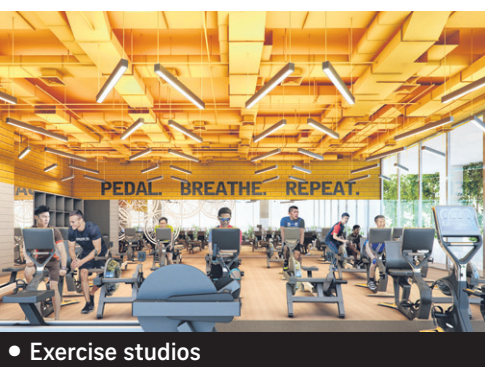

- The first purpose-built, all-weather facility for Individual Physical Proficiency Test (IPPT)

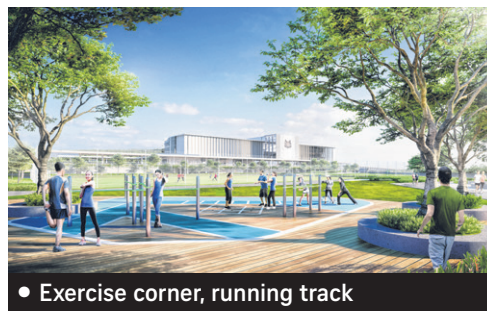


- Exercise studios

- Power 98 and 88.3Jia live radio and performance studios

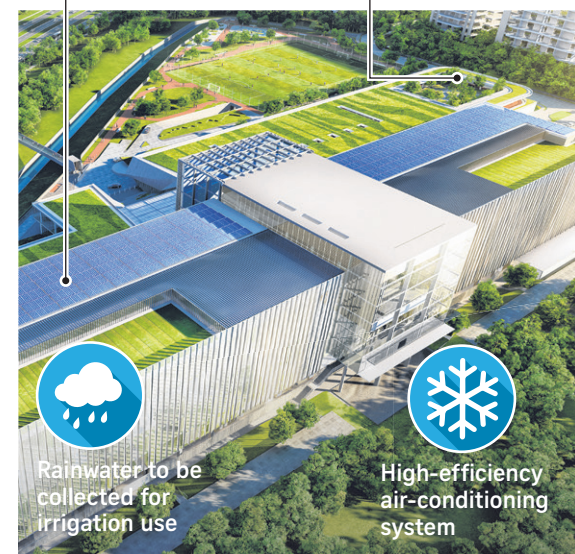
