

Registering your unmanned aircraft

From April 2, it will be an offence to operate an unregistered unmanned aircraft with a total weight of above 250g in Singapore.

UNMANNED AIRCRAFT

An unmanned aircraft (UA) is an aircraft that can be flown or used without anyone on board to operate it. Some examples of UA include radio-controlled aircraft, drones and remote-controlled kites.

HOW TO REGISTER*

Two-step UA registration process:

1. Purchase a registration label



• UA registration labels can be purchased online (caas.gov.sg/UAregistration) or at designated Singapore Post outlets.



• A registration fee of \$15 will be collected at the point of purchase of each registration label.

2. Complete the registration online

After purchasing the registration label, follow these three steps.



1. STICK

Stick the registration label on the main body of the UA.



2. SNAP

Take a picture of the UA with the affixed label.



3. REGISTER

Complete the UA registration online at caas.gov.sg/UAregistration

*NOTE: Registrants must be at least 16 years old at registration.
