6 The Istana Lama in Telok Blangah – built for Temenggong Abdul Rahman in 1824 – was refurbished with concrete structures in 1830 by Temenggong Daeng Ibrahim. Istana Lama served as the office of dignitaries from the region. It was demolished in 1954 and replaced with a Bata shoe factory.



7 Istana Engku Khalid, a grand-looking bungalow, once stood at the foot of Mount Faber. Radin Mas Primary School operated out of the building from 1926 to the 1980s before it was demolished. It was built by Temenggong Daeng Ibrahim for his son Engku Khalid.
