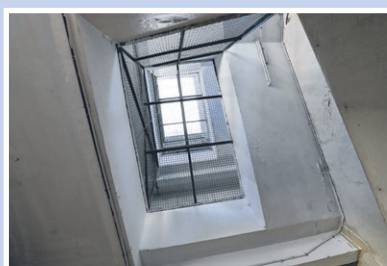
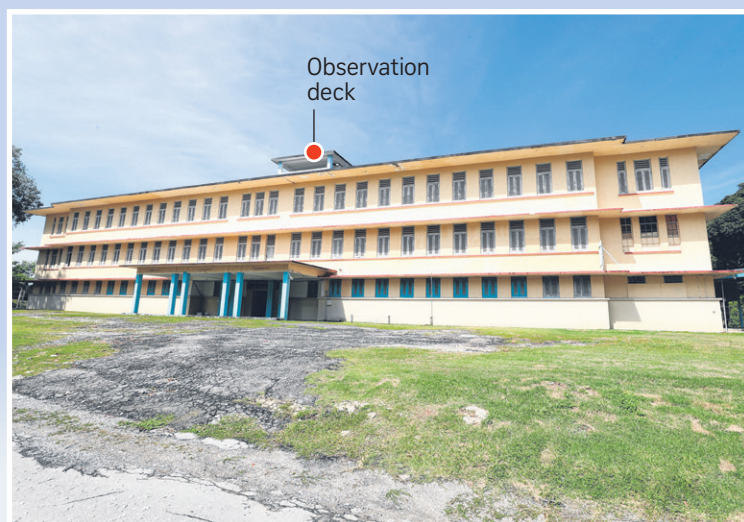


Visit historical WWII sites

The former View Road Hospital and the former Admiralty House and Bunker are among the guided tours that the public can sign up for under the National Heritage Board's Battle For Singapore programme this year. Both sites are usually closed to the public.

Former View Road Hospital

- This building was likely used by the Japanese during the Occupation of Singapore as a lookout point for the northern coastline.



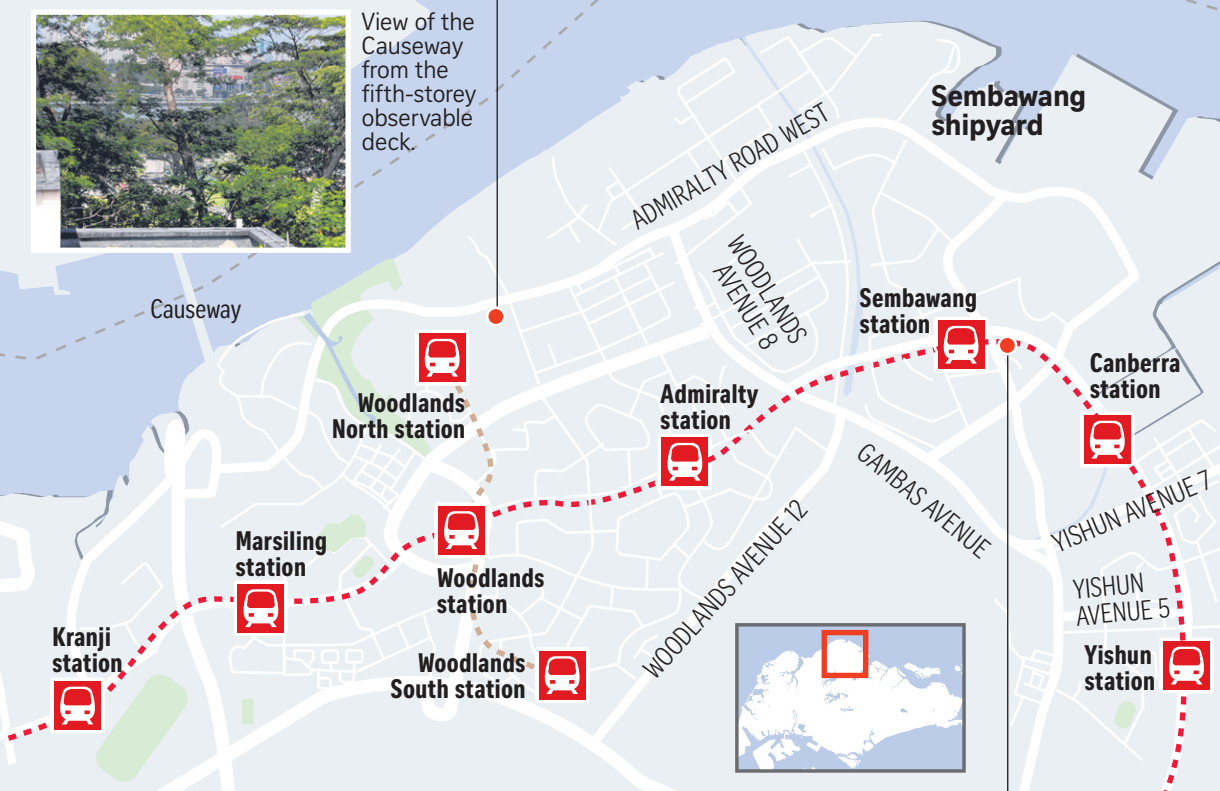
Staircase leading to the observation deck of the former hospital.

- The building accommodated key military commanders after its completion in 1940.
