

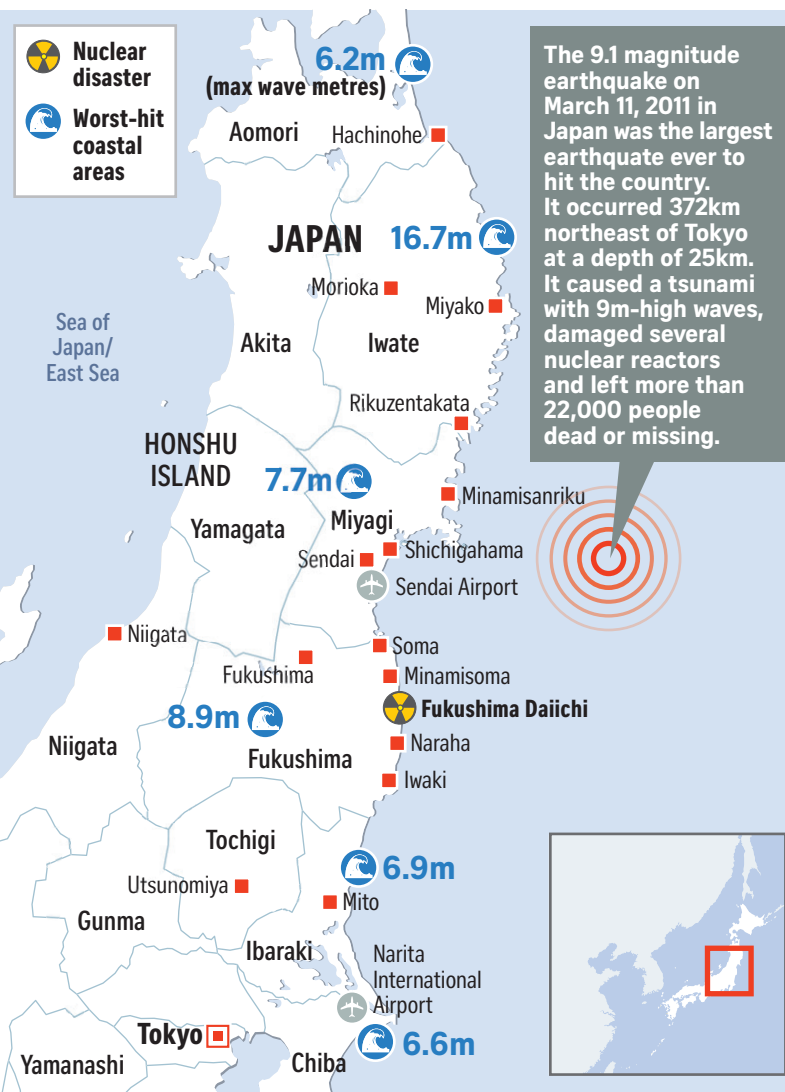
# Disaster-hit Fukushima

The 9.1 magnitude earthquake on March 11, 2011 in Japan was the largest earthquake ever to hit the country. It occurred 372km northeast of Tokyo at a depth of 25km. It caused a tsunami with 9m-high waves, damaged several nuclear reactors and left more than 22,000 people dead or missing.
