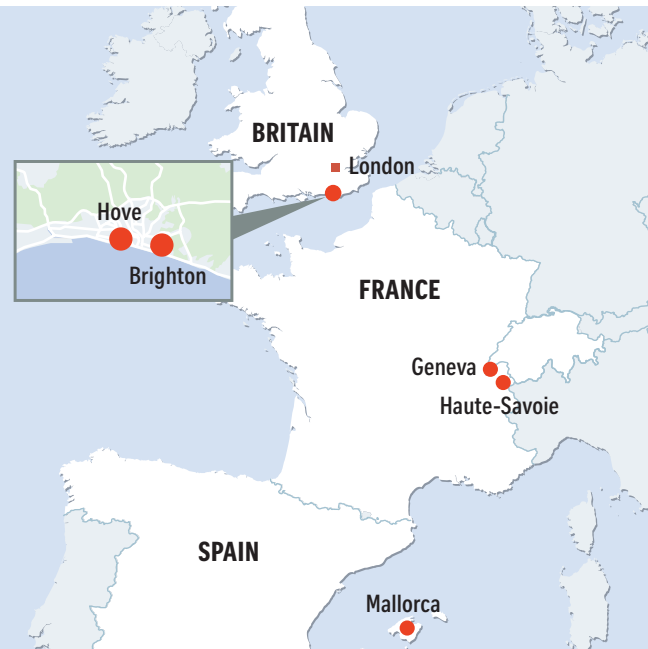


# Travelling with the virus

Briton Steve Walsh, 53, was infected with the coronavirus while attending a conference in Singapore and spread it to at least 11 other people before being diagnosed in Britain. His case has raised concern about how rapidly the virus can spread in a globalised world.



## Jan 20-22: Singapore

Attends business conference at Grand Hyatt Singapore. The event had 109 participants, 94 of them from overseas, including at least one Chinese national from Hubei province.

## Jan 24-28: Haute-Savoie in French Alps

Visits family and friends at the Contamines-Montjoie ski resort.

## Jan 28

Returns to his home in Hove, East Sussex, in Britain.

## Feb 2

- Goes to medical centre in Brighton after coming down with fever and later tests positive for the coronavirus.
- Two medical centre staff members later test positive, according to media reports.

## Feb 6

Transferred to infectious diseases unit at Guy's and St Thomas' Hospital in London.

## Feb 8

- 5 Britons who had contact with him test positive.
- 1 Briton tests positive in Mallorca, Spain.

## Feb 10

- 4 more Britons test positive, all known contacts of the Briton who were infected in France.
