

# 'Circuit breaker' to stop rising infections



- All non-essential workplaces to close from April 7 to May 4



- All public services available but counter staff reduced because of safe distancing; markets, supermarkets, hospitals, and transport and key banking facilities will remain open



- Eateries will remain open but only for takeaways or delivery



- Schools to switch to home-based learning from April 8 to May 4; mid-year exams cancelled but national exams to proceed with safety measures



- Services at pre-schools and student care centres to be suspended but they will be open to children of parents in essential services who can't find care arrangements



- Attractions, museums, casinos, sports facilities, country clubs and gyms and fitness centres will shut



- Reusable masks will be distributed at CCs and RC centres from tomorrow to April 12



- NSmen activities deferred until after May 4
