DANCE-POI DEDICATED SIDE B Carly Rae Jepsen ★★★☆



It is hard to believe that Canadian singer-songwriter Carly Rae Jepsen's (right) latest surprise album drop – singer-songwriter Carly Rae Jepsen's (right) latest surprise album drop – filled with joyous, sparkling pop songs – is essentially a collection of songs that did not make it into her previous album, Dedicated (2019). Granted, she had 200 songs written for Dedicated to choose from, but there are some real gens on this B-side that stay in the same "modern take on 1980s synth-pop" vein. Within that sphere, she still manages to show off her range. This Is What They Say, co-written with English singer Dev Hynnes (also known as Blood Orange), is an instant R&B earworm straight out of the late 1980s, while the floaty, atmospheric Heartbeat is an affecting, slow burner of a ballad, complete with tinkling piano keys.

Back-to-back songs, Felt This Way ("How come I can't stay away?") transitions into Stay Away with the same lyrical refrain of "How can I stay away?", almost like showing off how good she can make two different songs sound, with similar themes and lyrics.
