Recommendations by the International Civil Aviation Organisation

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| 1  Travel light All luggage checked in except small hand luggage that fits under the seat. | 2  Restrict toilet access Where possible, one toilet for crew only, and passengers should use a designated toilet based on seat assignment. |
| 3  Cover up Face masks must be worn. | 4  In-flight supplies Reduce use of non-essential in-flight supplies, such as blankets and pillows. |
| 5  Seating It does not advocate leaving every other seat open but asks passengers to remain as far from one another as possible. | 6  In-flight meals Limit or suspend food and beverage service on short-haul flights or serve them in sealed, pre-packaged containers. |
| 7  Duty-free shopping and reading materials <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Limits on size and quantity of duty-free sales.• Newspapers and magazines should be removed. | |
