

Guilty of breeding mozzies

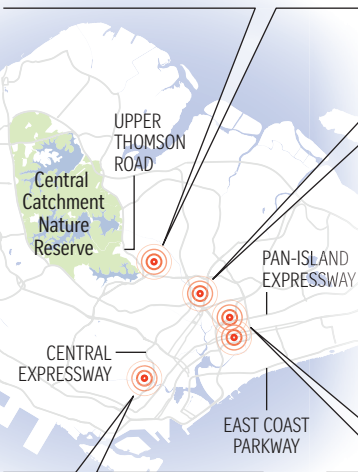
From July 15, the NEA will impose heavier penalties on households, construction sites and town councils which commit serious mosquito-breeding offences. Here are some of the premises found during the agency's inspections to be guilty of mosquito breeding.

WHERE

Residential premises located on the periphery of the dengue cluster in **Clover Avenue**

OFFENCE

Three instances of profuse mosquito breeding were detected in pails and a porcelain bowl, one of which had 50 mosquito larvae



WHERE

A construction site by Lian Beng Group within the dengue cluster in **Potong Pasir Avenue 1**

OFFENCE

Multiple mosquito-breeding habitats found on several occasions. Breeding grounds included a canvas sheet and a hollow metal pole, among others

WHERE

Residential premises within the dengue cluster in **Arnasalam Chetty Road/Kim Yam Road**

OFFENCE

Three instances of profuse mosquito breeding on the premises, including in a flower pot, a container cover and a water feature in which a few hundred mosquito larvae were found

WHERE

Two residential premises within a dengue cluster in **Aljunied Road/Geylang Road**

OFFENCE

Mosquito breeding found on multiple occasions, including in a jacuzzi where breeding was detected on two separate occasions, in a cooking pot and on a canvas sheet

Mosquito breeding was also uncovered in **common areas of Housing Board estates** managed by town councils or residents' committees, including in an unused incense burner, among others.
