Now, as the world's most expensive defender makes his first return to his old club, the £85 million (S\$150.2 million) man could play a part in costing Vardy the Premier League's Golden Boot.





Wilfred Ndidi v Bruno Fernandes

Fernandes has been United's catalyst since his January signing and has never lost a Premier League game. But he was subdued in Wednesday's draw with West Ham, perhaps his poorest performance. Ndidi has not recaptured the form he demonstrated in the first half of the season but he must snuff the Portuguese out.





Wes Morgan v Anthony Martial

Caglar Soyuncu's suspension means the 36-year-old Morgan has been pressed back into service, a Premier League champion trying to get Leicester into the Champions League. Yet he is particularly ill-suited to facing forwards of Martial's pace. The Frenchman is tied with Marcus Rashford on 22 goals in a battle to be United's top scorer.
