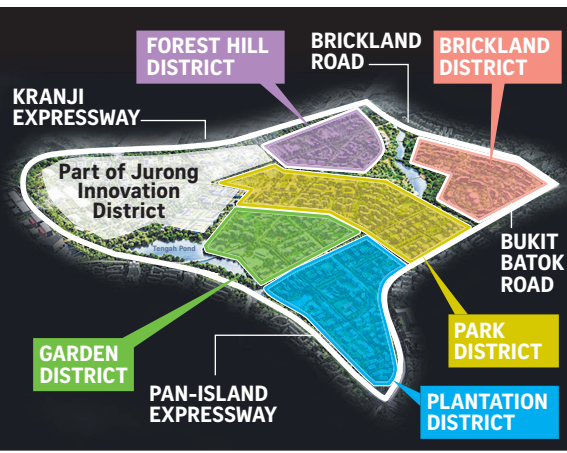


# Lush greenery in the Park

Park, the third of five districts in the Tengah estate, will have an estimated 7,200 new flats when fully developed.



## TENGAH TOWN CENTRE

- Singapore's first "car-free" town centre that will be integrated with the nearby Central Park
- Features an array of commercial and retail spaces, eateries and a sports centre
- Directly linked to an MRT station, one of four stations along the future Jurong Region Line



## PARK CORRIDOR

- Landscaped pathways to complement the cycling and pedestrian paths within the town and connect to the town centre



## CENTRAL PARK

- The green lung and centrepiece of Tengah, located next to Park district
- Features a "forest stream": an existing canal that will be naturalised and landscaped



## FOREST CORRIDOR

- A 100m-wide and 5km-long corridor that will link Tengah to the surrounding green spaces between the western and central catchment areas

## RAINFOREST WALK

- A 1.5km-long green space resembling a tropical rainforest that weaves through the various housing projects
- Playgrounds within the space will take on a rainforest theme



## PARC RESIDENCES @ TENGAH

- The first BTO housing parcel to be launched for sale in the new Park district
- Public housing in two of the districts – Plantation and Garden – has been launched while units in the last two districts – Brickland and Forest Hill – will be launched at a later date



- 12 residential blocks
- 1,044 units of 2-room flexi, 3-room, 4-room and 5-room flats
- Sky Galleria, an elevated landscaped linkway on the eighth storey extends greenery through the housing estate



- Integrated with a neighbourhood centre and a polyclinic
