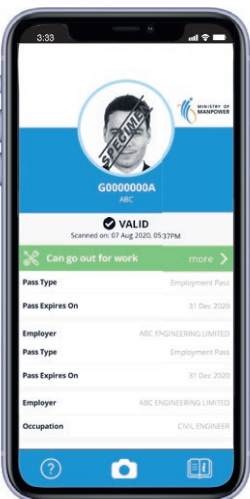


Digital solutions to manage workers

These are some of the digital solutions the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) has been using to manage the health and movements of over 1 million migrant workers during the Covid-19 pandemic.

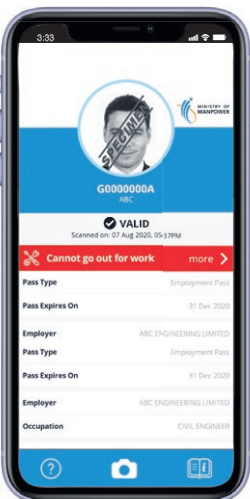
ACCESSCODE SYSTEM

- Launched on June 1 after three to four weeks of development involving multiple government agencies; **over 1 million users**



- A "traffic light" system to indicate workers who are allowed to go back to work (green, left) and those who are not (red, below)

- Criteria include the worker's health, whether his dorm is cleared, and if the employer has been approved to restart work



- Workers can use the SGWorkPass app to view their status and show it in order to leave their dorms for work

- Employers can use the Safe@Work online service to check all their workers' AccessCode statuses and find out the reasons why, if red

STAY-HOME NOTICE (SHN) SMARTWATCH

- Issued to workpass holders and dependants, entering Singapore after Aug 10, 11.59pm, serving SHN outside dedicated facilities

- Has a SIM card and GPS and 4G technology, and alerts MOM if the wearer leaves their residence or attempts to tamper with it



- Comes with a portable powerbank. The waterproof watch needs to be charged about two to three times during a 14-day SHN

- Also has a heartbeat sensor so MOM can track the wearer's health

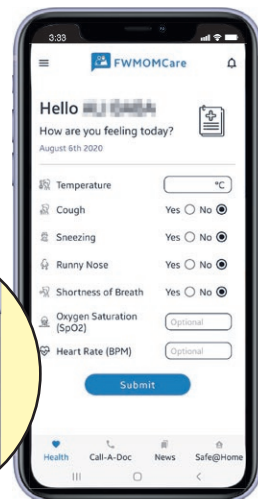
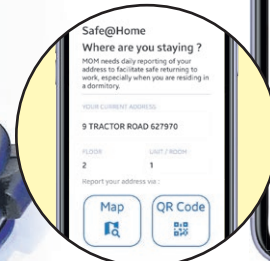


- Once worn, it is locked and cannot be removed until the end of the SHN, where it is disinfected at a return point for future use

FWMOMCARE MOBILE APP

- Launched on May 18 after over a month of development, **over 414,000 users**

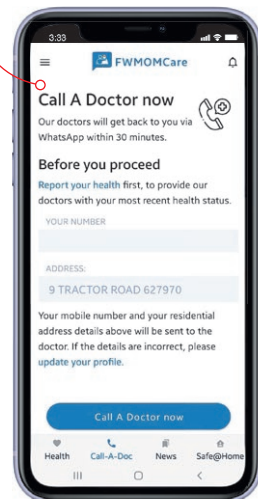
- Used by workers to report their temperature and health, and to scan QR codes at their dorms and workplaces to report their location



- If unwell, workers can use it to arrange for a tele-consultation service run by the Ministry of Health, typically available within half an hour

- A feature to display electronic discharge memos for workers who have recovered from Covid-19 was included on July 23

- Updates with important news and notifications on the ongoing Covid-19 situation
