### Jobs Support Scheme

Support for wages extended up to March 2021.

### Jobs Growth Incentive

For each new local hire, Government will provide wage subsidy for

- **Up to 25%** for those below 40 years old, subject to cap.
- **Up to 50%** for those aged 40 and above, subject to cap.



## TRANSFORMING THE ECONOMY

Set aside

# Up to \$150 million

to enhance the Startup SG Founder programme in phases.

- Raise the start-up capital grant.
- Continue to provide mentorship.



## SUPPORTING WORKERS

### Covid-19 Support Grant (CSG)

Application period extended up to Dec 2020.

Open to both existing CSG recipients and new applicants from Oct 1, 2020.

Unemployed applicants must demonstrate job search or training efforts to qualify.

### Workfare Special Payment

Eligibility widened to those who received Workfare Income Supplement for work done in 2020, and who are not already receiving the Special Payment.

One-off payment of

# \$3,000

to be received from Oct 2020 onwards.



## PRESERVING CORE CAPABILITIES

Further support for hardest-hit sectors such as aerospace, aviation and tourism to retain core capabilities.

# \$187 million

to extend support measures in the Enhanced Aviation Support Package up to March 2021.

- Cost relief for airlines, ground handlers, cargo agents and airport tenants.
- Support local carriers to regain Singapore's air connectivity to the world.

Temporary redeployment programme scaled up for workers in the aviation sector.

# \$320 million

to boost domestic tourism through tourism credits (SingapoRediscovered Vouchers).
