- Develop a more diverse public service by recruiting officers from different backgrounds



Accelerate digitalisation in Government

- Make digital services accessible to all citizens, especially seniors and the less digitally literate
- Strengthen the government data security regime
- Build up the national digital infrastructure to support seamless digital transactions and commerce
