# Back in the spotlight

LeBron James is back in the National Basketball Association (NBA) Finals. It's his ninth appearance in 10 years and first with the Los Angeles Lakers. The Lakers return to the biggest stage for the first time since 2010, while the Miami Heat re-emerge after six years. The match-up marks the first time in NBA history that the finalists did not reach the play-offs in the previous season.
