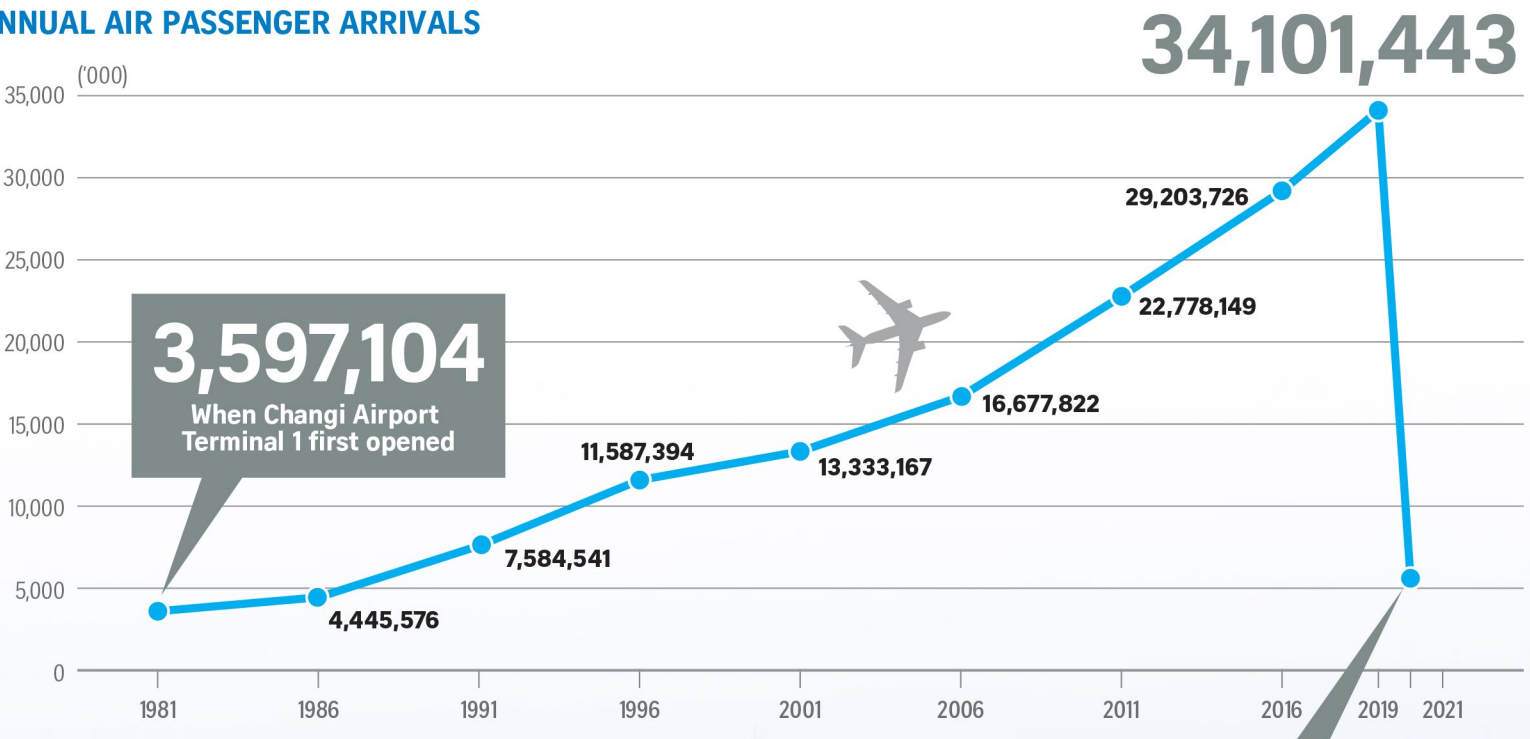


Revitalising Singapore's air hub
