## Four levels of rating

The Cybersecurity Labelling Scheme comprises four levels of rating, represented by up to four asterisks signifying the tiers of testing and assessment that a product has undergone. The label will be valid for the period that the device is supported with security updates, up to a maximum of three years.

## # Level 1

The product meets basic security requirements such as ensuring unique default passwords and providing software updates.



The product has been developed with security incorporated into the design and appropriate tests have been carried out. It has also fulfilled Level 1 requirements.

## **★ \* \*** Level 3

The product's software has been analysed by approved third-party labs. The product has also fulfilled Level 2 requirements.

The product has undergone simulated cyber attacks by approved third-party labs to test its security capabilities. It has also fulfilled Level 3 requirements.
