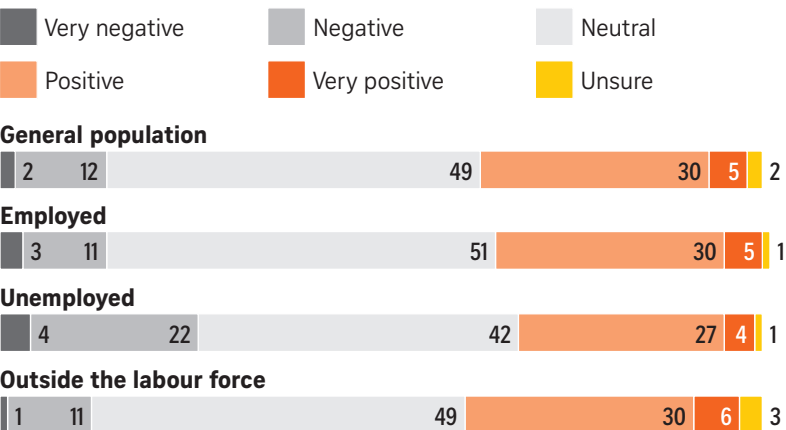
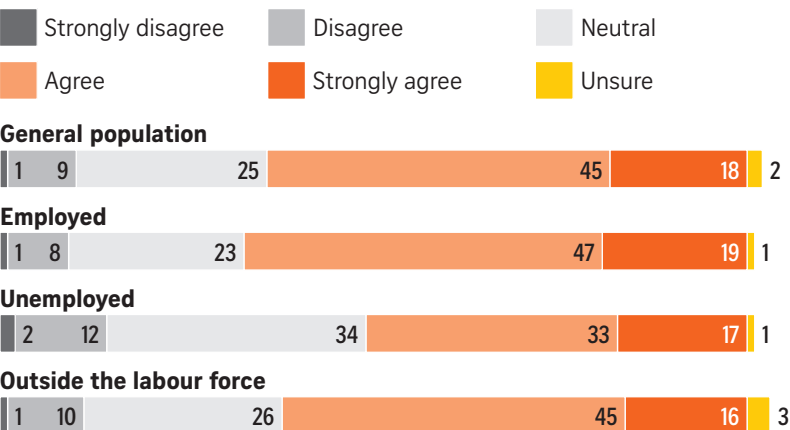


What Singaporeans think about foreigners

In general, how do you feel about foreigners (i.e. non-citizens) in Singapore? (% among all respondents by employment status)

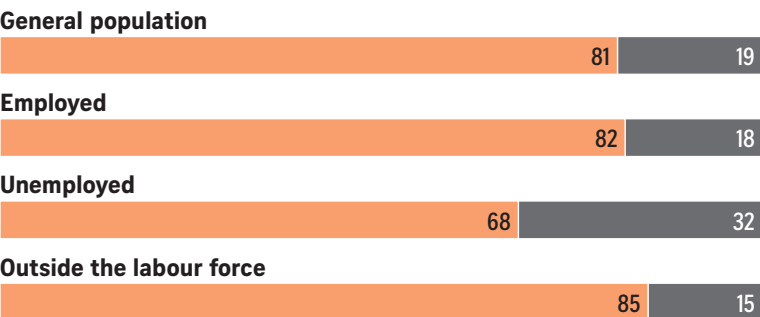


It is important that Singapore remains open to foreigners (% among all respondents by employment status)
