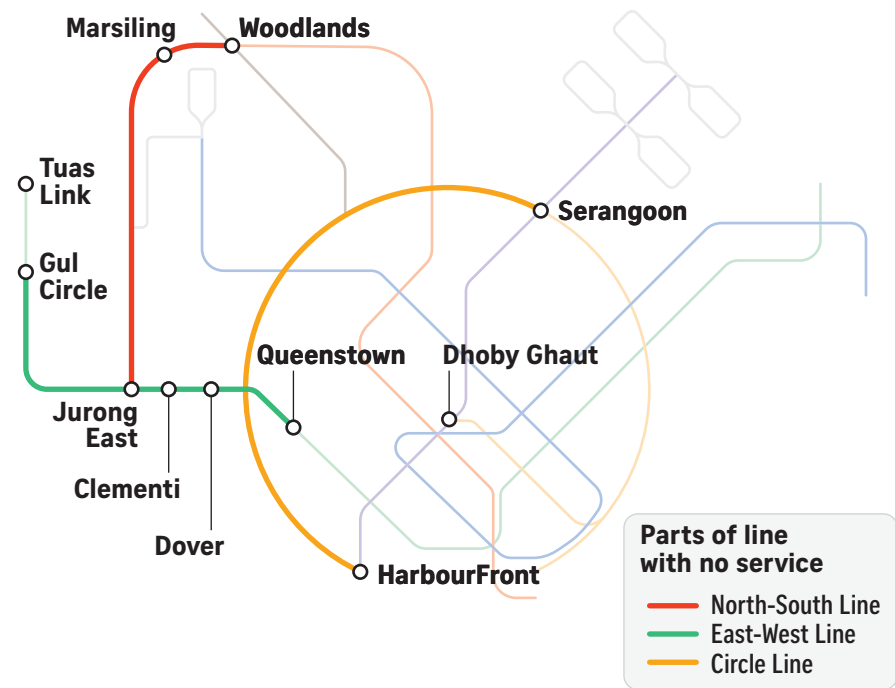


Timeline of breakdown

Yesterday evening, a disruption hit three MRT lines during the rush hour. Here is a look at the affected stations and how the breakdown unfolded.



7pm

— **NORTH-SOUTH LINE**
— **EAST-WEST LINE**
Power fault causes disruption.

7.16pm

— **NORTH-SOUTH LINE**
Power fault between Woodlands and Jurong East – commuters told to add 25min of travel time.

7.17pm

— **EAST-WEST LINE**
Power fault between Queenstown and Gul Circle – commuters told to add 25min train travel time.

7.23pm

— **EAST-WEST LINE**
Disruption extends to Tuas Link.

7.30pm

— **CIRCLE LINE**
Power fault causes disruption.

7.31pm

— **EAST-WEST LINE**
SMRT confirms there is no train service between Clementi and Gul Circle; passengers advised to avoid Jurong East Interchange.

7.32pm

— **NORTH-SOUTH LINE**
SMRT confirms there is no train service between Woodlands and Jurong East.

7.49pm

— **NORTH-SOUTH LINE**
SMRT says there is no service between Marsiling and Jurong East.

8.13pm

— **CIRCLE LINE**
SMRT confirms there is no train service between Serangoon and HarbourFront.

8.21pm

— **EAST-WEST LINE**
SMRT says there is no service between Dover and Tuas Link.

8.27pm

— **CIRCLE LINE**
SMRT reports disruption from Dhoby Ghaut to Serangoon, says to add 25min to travelling time.

8.40pm

— **CIRCLE LINE**
SMRT reports line is being progressively restored, adds 25min to travelling time.

10.35pm

— **NORTH-SOUTH LINE**
— **EAST-WEST LINE**
Train services resume.
