Subject-based banding (Secondary) eligibility criteria

PSLE subject grade	Option to take the subject at
AL 5 or better in a Standard-level subject	Express level
AL 6 or better in a Standard-level subject or AL A in a Foundation-level subject	N(A) level

New scoring system

Achievement level	Marks
1	90 and above
2	85-89
3	80-84
4	75-79
5	65-74
6	45-64
7	20-44
8	Below 20

NOTE: A pupil's total score will be the sum of the achievement level of each of the four subjects. A pupil who has attained AL1 in all four subjects will have a PSLE score of four, the best result possible.
