

Singapore Airlines' tentative recovery

Pre-pandemic

1,243 flights a week to 92 destinations

Pre-Covid-19, there were seven weekly flights to Chongqing and 28 weekly flights to Shanghai. There were also 57 other flights to Chinese cities like Beijing, Guangzhou and Xiamen

To China

Now
108 flights a week to 37 destinations – including Phnom Penh, Jakarta, Chongqing, Seoul, Johannesburg, Frankfurt, Paris and Los Angeles

SIA and SilkAir have one weekly flight to Chongqing and 1 to Shanghai in November and December

To Hong Kong:

Pre-Covid-19, there were 49 weekly flights

SIA and SilkAir have 10 weekly flights scheduled for November and December

Now, SIA group is operating at



9.5% of pre-Covid-19 capacity

By end-December, it is projected to reach 15%

Destinations to be added in coming months: Brunei, Fukuoka, Kathmandu and Male

Since the Hong Kong air travel bubble was announced, economy flight prices between Singapore and Hong Kong have surged

30% to 40%
