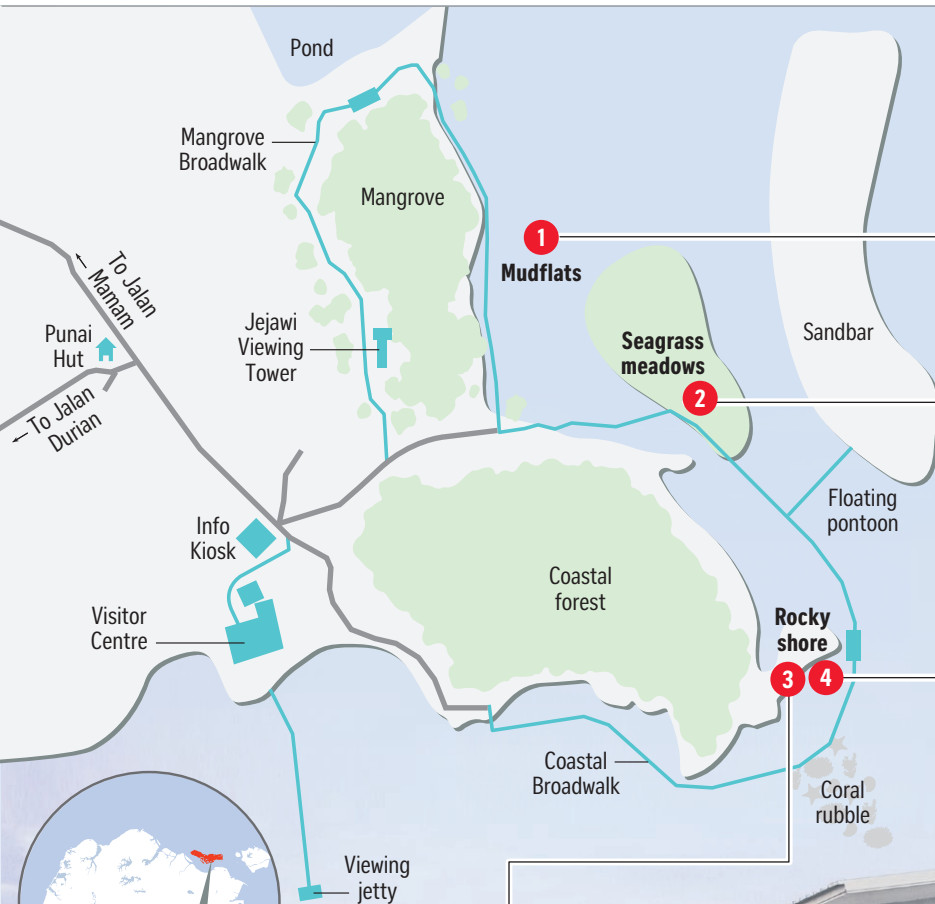


# Patchwork island

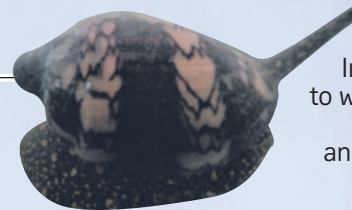
Offshore Pulau Ubin is a treasure trove of wildlife, and one reason for this is the variety of habitats on the island. One of Ubin's main draws is the Chek Jawa Wetlands, which is itself host to habitats such as mudflats, rocky shores and mangroves.



At low tide, animals such as wild boars emerge onto the mudflats at Chek Jawa to forage for food.



Dugongs are known to leave trails behind in the meadows as they feed.



Intertidal area. This zone refers to where sea meets land between high and low tides. Interesting animals like the noble volute sea snail can be found here.

Rocky shores can be found in the intertidal zone. It is home to animals such as sea stars and a variety of crabs and molluscs.
