

Singapore's climate in 2020

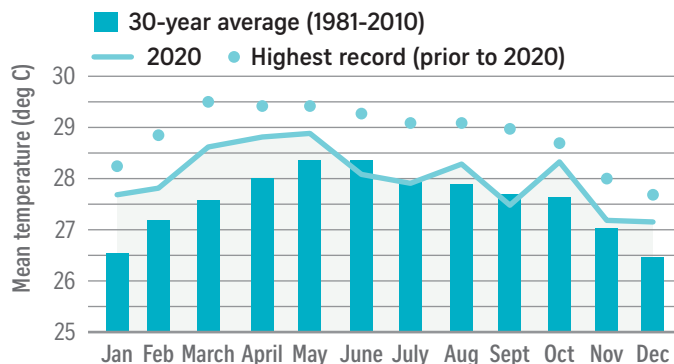
ANNUAL MEAN TEMPERATURE

28 deg C

0.5 deg C higher than the 1981-2010 long-term average and ranks as the eighth warmest on record.

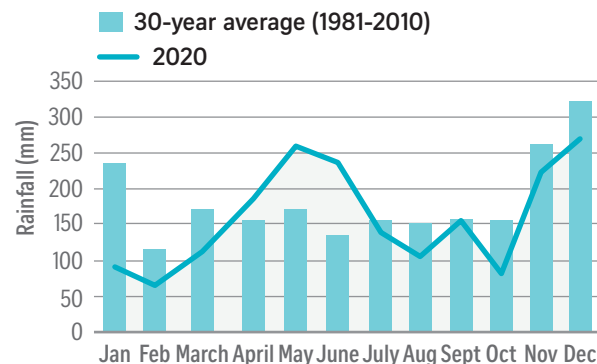
MONTHLY MEAN TEMPERATURE

The record 28 consecutive months of warmer-than-average mean temperatures that started in February 2018 ended with cooler-than-average temperatures in June last year.



MONTHLY TOTAL RAINFALL

The Changi climate station recorded rainfall of 1,886.6mm last year – the eighth driest year in the last 30 years.



NOTABLE WEATHER EVENTS



Rainy June

The Changi climate station recorded 21 rain days, the most in June in the last 30 years. It was also the second-coolest June in the last 20 years.



Coollest day

Intense thundery showers brought the temperature to a cool 20.9 deg C on Sept 16, the coolest day of the year. Overall, September was one of only two months last year with below-average temperature.



October Sumatra squalls

14 Sumatra squalls passed through Singapore in October, bringing widespread rain and gusty winds. Tropical cyclones in the South China Sea contributed to the high frequency.
