
# Singapore's climate in 2020

### ANNUAL MEAN TEMPERATURE

0.5 deg C higher than the 1981-2010 long-term average and ranks as the eighth warmest on record.


## MONTHLY MEAN TEMPERATURE

The record 28 consecutive months of warmer-than-average mean temperatures that started in February 2018 ended with cooler-than-average temperatures in June last year.



#### MONTHLY TOTAL RAINFALL

The Changi climate station recorded rainfall of 1.886.6mm last year - the eighth driest year in the last 30 years.



## NOTABLE WEATHER EVENTS



## **Rainy June**

The Changi climate station recorded 21 rain days, the most in June in the last 30 years. It was also the second-coolest June in the last 20 years.



### **Coolest day**

Intense thundery showers brought the temperature to a cool 20.9 deg C on Sept 16, the coolest

day of the year. Overall, September was one of only two months last year with below-average temperature.



#### **October** Sumatra squalls

14 Sumatra squalls passed through Singapore in October, bringing

widespread rain and gusty winds. Tropical cyclones in the South China Sea contributed to the high frequency.
