Most economic and social activities will cease from tomorrow to June 14 as Malaysia enters a total lockdown to stem rising Covid-19 infections. Here are the key restrictions.

BUSINESS ACTIVITIES



Shopping malls and most factories shut

Transport services to continue running

Banking and financial services allowed

Food and beverage outlets can operate, for takeaway and delivery



Supermarkets, pharmacies, petrol stations stay open

Opticians, hardware

workshops can open

stores and vehicle





Hotels can operate, but for quarantine purposes only

Critical construction work, like maintenance of public infrastructure, can continue

INDIVIDUAL ACTIVITIES



Limited to travel within a 10km radius from home

Only two people per household allowed out to buy essentials

TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS



No inter-district or inter-state travel



Individual exercise, like jogging, allowed up to 8pm



No social gatherings or house visits



Existing travel permits expire today
