KEY TERMS

Opening up skies

- Airlines from Asean and the EU will be able to fly any number of services between both regions.
- They can also fly up to 14 weekly passenger services with one stop within the other region.
- There is no limit on flights with one stop to pick up cargo.

Closer cooperation

- Both regions will work together on aviation safety, air traffic management, consumer protection, and environmental matters.
- The agreement also reflects the latest thinking, including on fair competition, creating a more conducive business climate for Asean and EU airlines.
