

## By the numbers



**177,000**

Employment Pass (EP) holders in Singapore's overall workforce, as at 2020.



**4,200**

intra-corporate transferees working in Singapore in 2020, of which about 500 were from India.



From 2005 to 2020, number of EP holders rose by around

**112,000.**

Over this period, number of local professionals, managers and executives increased by more than

**380,000.**



Over past three years, an average of **170** discrimination cases based on nationality handled annually by Tripartite Alliance for Fair and Progressive Employment Practices.

Total employment in 2020, excluding migrant domestic workers, shrank by

**166,600.**

Foreign employment fell by 181,500. Resident employment expanded by 14,900.



Finance and infocomm sectors accounted for

**40 per cent**

of the increase in EP holders.



Proportion of EP holders from India increased from about one-seventh of all EP holders in 2005, to one-quarter in 2020.
