SOME KEY POINTS

- Negotiations with the EU will begin only when Britain has officially announced its wish to leave.
- The government will have two years to negotiate a deal once Mrs May informs the EU by the end of March of Britain's intention to leave.
- Mrs May said she would not accept a deal that punishes Britain.
- Any divorce deal must be approved by both Chambers of Parliament.
