ESW Manage



Financial Frontiers, the private equity firm founded by Mr Bill Ng, has previously invested in ESW.

Zainudin Nordin



The former MP (Bishan-Toa Payoh) was FAS president from 2009 to 2016. Was listed as an ESW Manage director on April 15, 2017.

Woodlands Wellington

Bill Ng
